the said *John Elkins* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *One pound Eight Shillings and Eight pence Sterling*

on the said April One thousand Seven hundred & eighty four 1784 for one Year's Interest on the Principal Sum of *Twenty pounds ten Shillings and Eight pence Sterling*

and the like Interest Annually of Resolution of the General Assembly the twelfth August One thousand Seven hundred & eighty three.

The said *John Elkins* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Twenty pounds ten Shillings and Eight pence Sterling*

on the twelfth December One thousand Seven hundred & eighty five 1785 And the said *John Elkins* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner abovementioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforefaid ACT.
