

Know all Men by these presents that
whereas I met on the 24th day of
November 1811 Charles, Saml Muck, Mrs.
Walker, John Laurry, Mr. McIntosh George
The Ridge, Dickson, The Cabbins, Mrs.
McLarron, Duck, and Charles Gibbs on
behalf of the Cherokee, on the part
of the Nation and Thomas N. Clark
on his own part entered into a bond, that
the aforesaid parties should refer all matters
in dispute between the said Clark and
the said Cherokee aforesaid, respecting
six hundred and fifty five acres of land
which the said Clark then
had and held on the Cherokee, on the
first day of February 1812, And where
as the John Brown and Isaac C. H.
McLarron was chosen as Arbitrator of the
above dispute by the parties, on the
first day of February aforesaid and after
having been duly sworn, and after
having duly examined the following
six hundred and fifty five acres of land
to wit No. 1st 1 acre bill
to the said Clark signed by John Armstrong
Clark of the committee, William L. Lovely
David M. Hain the said William L. Lovely
John Walker Richard Brown George
Laurry the Duck and John D. Chestnut
for eleven hundred and fifty five dollars
on which there appears to be a balance
due to the said Clark of \$577.50

committee of Indian claims 20th November 1811
in which due bill there is taken \$4. 42 ³/₄ cts

No 5, 1 due bill for the sum of \$263, 34 ¹¹/₁₆ cts dated
30th May 1811, signed by the Black Fox and
Indian chiefs, attested by John Ross & pay-
able to Thomas M. Clark

No 6, 1 due bill payable to Barney Bremer
for the sum of \$282, dated the 29th August
1807 signed by John D. Chisler Richard
Brown John Lowrey and John Thompson ad-
mitted by the Committee of Indian claims
20th November 1811 in which there are the
sum of \$31, 75 ¹¹/₁₆ cts interest, the amount of

of which above recited sum bills, we do award and
say, which is two thousand and fifty dollars
and seven cents fifty six in cents, We the said John
Brown and Isaac Sel, mean the aforesaid
Arbitrators therefore do award and say that
the said Thomas N. Clark is entitled to sum
and of the before recited Indian chiefs whose
names are subscribed to the before mentioned
arbitration Bond, a draft on the Agent of
the Cherokee Nation for the before recited sum
of two thousand and fifty dollars and fifty
seven cents, and that he do give and sign return
and pay to the said Thomas N. Clark the aforesaid
sum of money according to the tenor
and affect of said Bond, and that the Indian
chiefs to wit John Lowrey, John Walker and
being then of the aforesaid Cherokee Nation and
after their make out a draft on the Agent
of the Cherokee Nation and deliver the same
to the said Thomas N. Clark for the aforesaid
sum of two thousand and fifty dollars
and fifty seven cents the day -
