

St. Louis May 2nd 1846

Sir Governor Clark will write to you and
inclose a copy of the Talk delivered by the
Commissioners to the Cherokee Chiefs, from
which you will perceive the manner in
which their complaints have been attended
to — I have it in charge from the Commis-
sioners to inform you that I have this day
settled and paid off Mr. Chisholm's acc^t
of expenses incurred in bringing up the
Chiefs with his own compensation of three
Dollars per day from the 2nd April up to
the 22nd May when he expects to arrive at
home and ^{has} furnished him with money to
bear their expenses back amounting to
Three Hundred and Twenty Dollars eighty
seven and a half cents \$320.87½
