at Nacogdoches this fifth day of September
a.d. 1839

September 5. 1839 for Six hundred & forty acres of land
was issued to Sam Christum by the Board of
Land Commissioners for the County of Nacogdoches, Texas.
I further Certify that Said Certificate was recommended
for Patent by the Commission appointed to Detect
Fraudulent Land Certificates &c. the Christian Name
appearing to have been corrected on the register of the
last named Commission & On the printed abstract of
of Certificates (furnished me from General Land Office)
the Name "James Christum" appearing opposite to
this Number & Class (the date is erroneous also it is printed
as being September 5. 1838 it should be September 5. 1839)
Now this the Name may have been Error in the Transcript
to the General Land Office or in the Compositor who
prepared it for print. As the records of said
Commissioners do not show any Certificate issued
to the Name "James Christum"

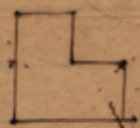
